<p>DOK 1:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recall facts or elements of a story - Answer factual questions - Find answers that are explicitly in the text - Use only the text to find the answer 	<p>Sample Questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - When did _____ happen? - What happened first? - What happened before _____? - What happened after _____? - How did the story end?
<p>DOK 2:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Apply a skill or concept to a new context - Infer based on details within a text - Find answers about the text - Use schema or background knowledge and the text to answer a question 	<p>Sample Questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What did (<u>character</u>) do when (<u>a main event</u>) happened? - What was the major problem? How was it solved? - Why do you think (<u>main event happened</u>)? - Why do you think (<u>conclusion of story</u>) happened? - What was the most important part of the story? Why do you think that?
<p>DOK 3:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use strategic thinking to answer a question - Think critically about the events of a story - Find answers beyond the text - Use the text, scheme, and problem solving to answer a question 	<p>Sample Questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How does the author or illustrator show what was happening? How did that help make this story interesting? - How does the author help you learn about _____? (Nonfiction) - How did (<u>main character</u>) try to solve the problem? Did it work? Why or why not? - Does this event remind you of something that happened in your life? What does it remind you of and why?
<p>DOK 4:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Extend thinking beyond answering questions to creating new ideas - Analyze, the text and create a new perspective that can be defended by facts from the text 	<p>Sample Tasks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recreate the story through theater or art (drawing, painting, etc) - Retell the story by in a different setting (for example, retell the story of Cinderella but have it take place in Minnesota)
